The Jewish Independent operates according to editorial values of accuracy, fairness, and transparency. We encourage respectful and constructive engagement among readers, in the spirit of tolerance, diversity, and open dialogue.

The Jewish Independent encourages intelligent and civil comments and discussion on our Social Media pages.

Please report apparent breaches either directly to the social media platform or by sending us a private message (e.g. using contact form on our website). While we monitor Social Media pages, there may be some delays in removing inappropriate comment.

Comments or private messages will breach our policy and may be deleted or hidden if in our opinion they:

- are abusive, off-topic or contain profanity or foul language;
- include ad hominem attacks against public or private individuals or organisations;
- contain disparaging remarks or threats against countries, ethnicities, religions or other categories of people;
- contain antisemitic, racist, sexist or homophobic language or other slurs;
- advertise and/or solicit links for personal blogs and websites;
- are spam or have been posted repeatedly;
- deliberately seek to provoke other commentators or The Jewish Independent staff or volunteers;
- constitute trolling of any description;
- are otherwise contrary to the promotion of intelligent and civil comments and discussion.

Repeated or serious breaches of the moderation policy may also result in the offender being barred from TJI and staff pages. We reserve the right to update the moderation policy as required.
